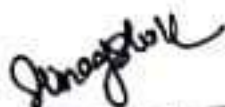
Report:

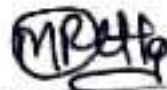

Day 1. Introduction to Consumer Protection and Human Rights – Overview of consumer rights and human rights, importance and relevance in today's society, historical background and evolution.

Day 2. Legal Framework and International Instruments – Laws and regulations governing consumer protection and human rights, international treaties and conventions, role of international organizations.

Day 3. Consumer Rights and Responsibilities – Detailed exploration and consumer rights, understanding responsibilities of consumers, case studies and real-life examples.

Day 4. Human Rights Principles and Concepts – Fundamental human rights principles, types of human rights (civil, political, economic, social, cultural), Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR)

Day 5. Consumer Protection Laws and Enforcement – National and regional consumer protection laws, enforcement mechanisms and agencies, consumer redressal mechanisms.

Day 6. Human Rights Institutions and Mechanisms – Role of human rights institutions (e.g. Human Rights Council), mechanisms for monitoring and reporting human rights violations, human rights advocacy and activism.

Day 7. Consumer Education and Awareness – Importance of consumer education, strategies for raising consumer awareness, digital literacy and consumer rights online, helpline number for consumer to file complaint.

Day 8. Vulnerable Consumer Groups – Rights of vulnerable consumer groups (children, elderly, disabled), challenges they face in accessing goods and services, legal protections and support systems.

Day 9. Intersection of Consumer Protection and Human Rights – How consumer protection and human rights intersect, case studies on human rights violations in consumer contexts, advocacy for consumer rights within human rights frameworks.

Day 10. Future Trends and Challenges – Emerging issues in consumer protection and human rights, technology's impact on consumer rights and human rights, strategies for addressing future challenges.

Report: A session on investment banking was held for the SY & TY students in association with Imarticus Learning, where in the speaker Mr. Mitul Mewada gave an overview on investment banking and how it works. Sir spoke about what is investment banking? What is merchant banking? etc. Investment banking is a financial services sector that involves helping companies and governments raise capital by underwriting and issuing securities, facilitating mergers and acquisitions (M&A), providing advisory services, and managing various financial transactions. Investment banks act as intermediaries between companies that need capital and investors looking to deploy their funds.

Investment banking is a special segment of banking operation that helps individuals or organizations raise capital and provide financial consultancy services to them. They act as intermediaries between security issuers and investors and help new firms to go public. Investment banking pertains to certain activities of a financial services company or a corporate division that consist in advisory-based financial transactions on behalf of individuals, corporations, and governments. There can sometimes be confusion between an investment bank and the investment banking division (IBD) of a bank. Full-service investment banks offer a wide range of services that include underwriting, M&A, sales and trading, equity research, asset management, commercial banking, and retail banking. The investment banking division of a bank provides only the underwriting and M&A advisory services.

"If helmet saves life, why not wear it?"

In India, 4 people die every hour because of not wearing helmet. This is a serious issue to be taken in account. Wearing a helmet decrease the risk and severity of injuries by 72 percent.

To educate people about the necessity of wearing helmet, and to create safety awareness, N.S.S Unit of Clara's College Of Commerce organized Training on 'Helmet for Life' in association with United Way Of Mumbai and Total Energy Foundation on 26th July 2023 at 10.00 am in the A.V Room. The Helmet for Life initiative aims to promote safe two-wheeler riding by educating people about the importance of wearing helmets for safety, creating awareness about safe riding practices, and motivating them to follow compliance norms, with the ultimate goal of reducing two-wheeler road accidents. He insisted that pillion should wear helmet. "A pillion is the most unaware person. Riders can be alert if they see danger ahead a few seconds before the mishap but the pillion, especially

children and youth, are not alert and often we find pillion riders have maximum fatalities," he added.

In a bid to inform and educate students the importance of head safety gear during riding or accompanying pillion riders, 25 free helmets were distributed to students. Overall, it was an interactive and informative session that helped in inculcating a sense of road safety among the young students of our country.

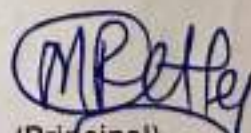
The camp ended at 5pm .It was a proud moment for the NSS unit for successfully organizing this Blood Donation Camp.
