

E) Objective: The objective was to ensure that participants understand the procedures which need to be followed in the event of fire and to raise awareness of the Importance of fire safety in Society.

F) DESCRIPTION:

Fire poses a tremendous safety risk for any business, workplace or organization – one of the biggest safety issues we see, in fact, yet one that is sometimes overlooked or underestimated. An important aspect of any prevention process requires the full awareness of the risks and impacts. Fire safety awareness is the important starting point in an integrated fire safety plan for every business.

With an objective to create awareness about fire safety and the usage of fire extinguishing equipment, A Virtual training on Fire Safety was organized by NSS unit in collaboration with BCOM and BAF departments of Clara's College of Commerce on July 22, 2021. The programme aimed at making participants mindful about fire hazards and the safety measures which can be taken during fire emergency.

Dr. Babita Kanojia, B.COM Coordinator welcomed and introduced the guests, Ms. Abhidnya Vartak, and Mr. Rajan Shelar, DM instructors, Resilient foundation. They talk revolved around how fire-safety is vital and what are various kinds of safeguards which should be taken at different fire-prone areas.

They discussed about several types of materials which cause fire and how that fire can be ceased. Giving examples of fire emerged due to petrol and LPG, Mr. Rajan Shelar also discussed the scientific reasons behind why some things catch fire quickly, while some items are the last to burn, like bricks. Ms. Abhidnya Vartak mentioned that fire equipment is manufactured on the basis of five types of fire which are categorized as follows:

Type A- Caused due to wood, cloth, coal

Type B- Caused due to all kinds of inflammable liquids like kerosene, petrol

Type C- Caused due to all kinds of inflammable gases

Type D- Caused due to rise in temperature of various metals

Type E- Caused due to short-circuit in any electric equipment

They also discussed about the safety measures at home and public places. The talk was followed by a Q&A session.



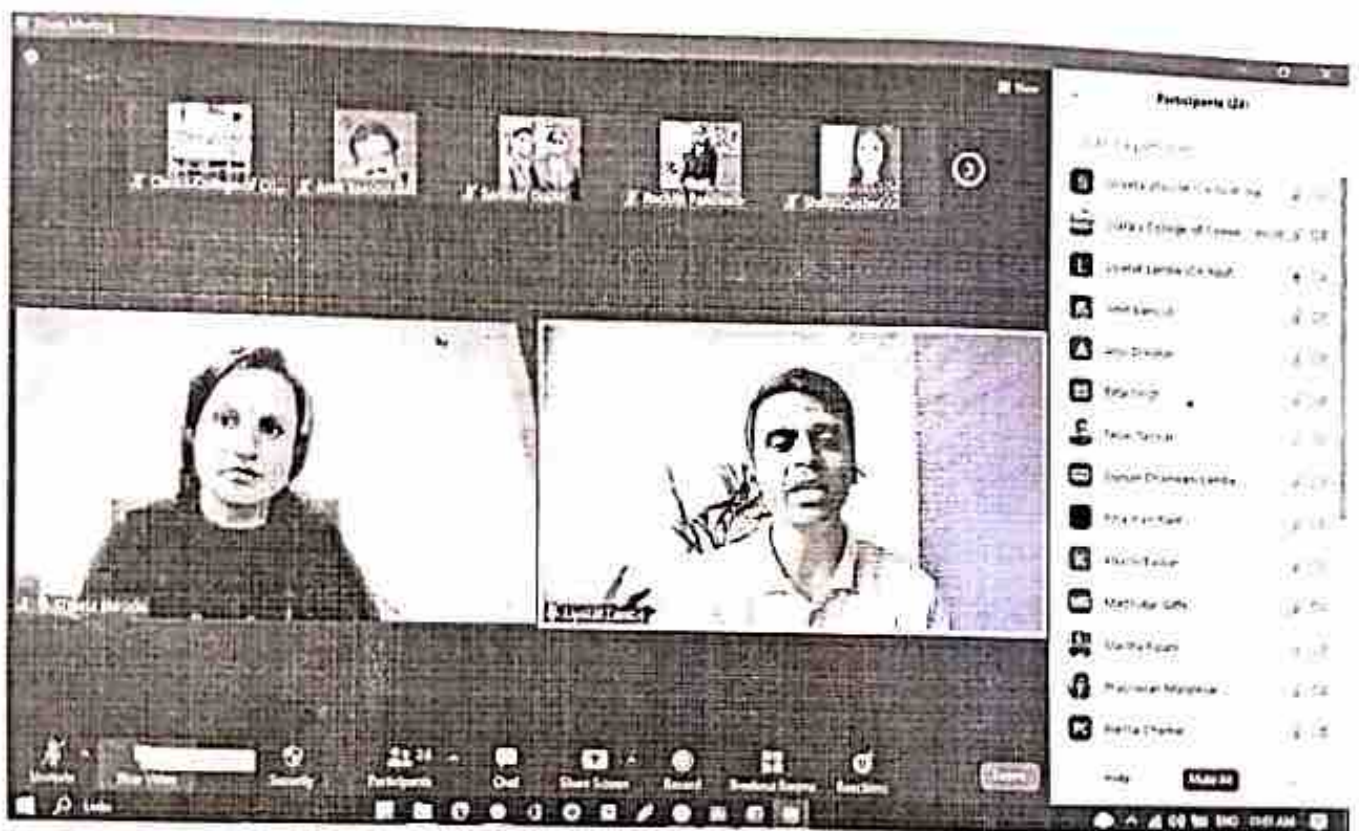

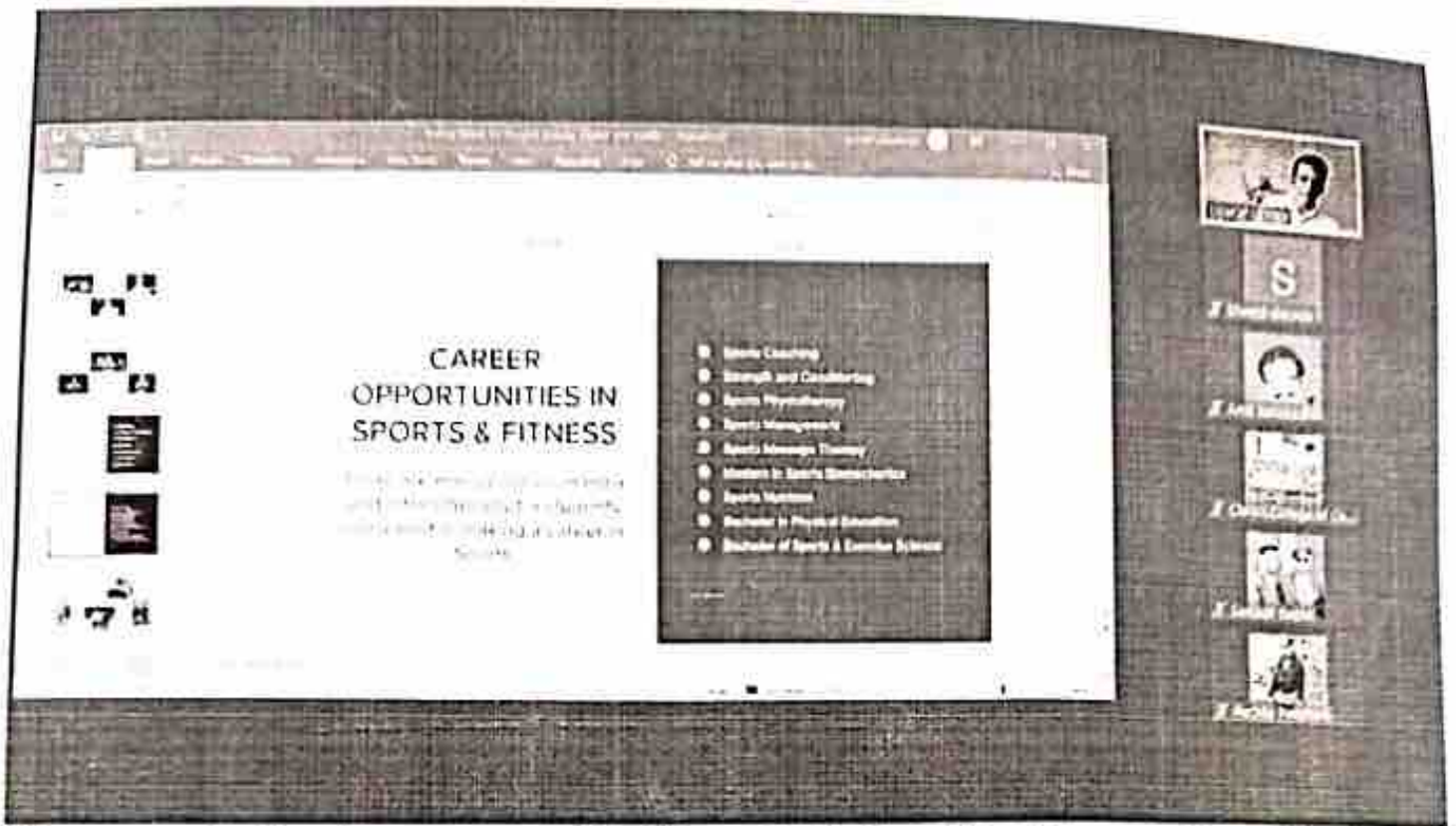
