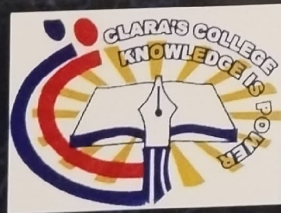


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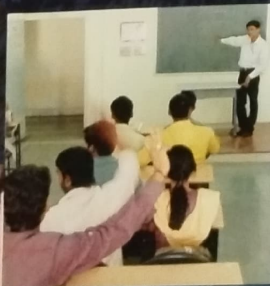

With that thought, I offer my gratitude to entire team of CWC, the teachers, staff members, parents and students alike, for their contribution in presenting us, yet another accomplishing year.

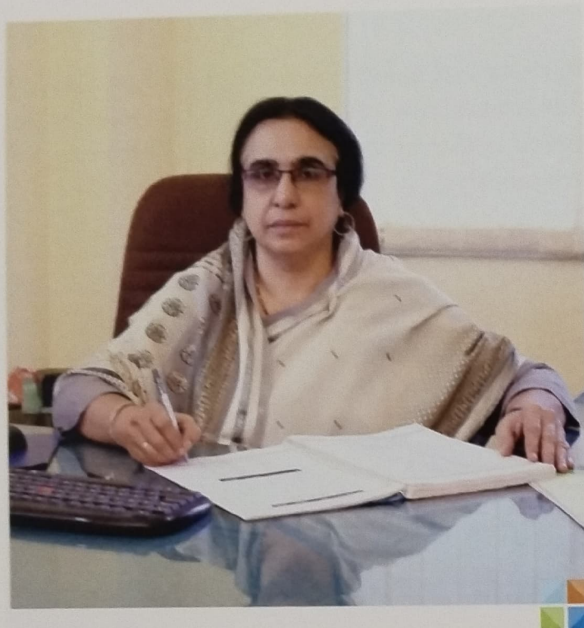

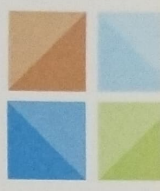

Zeal and the zealous, prevailed all-round the year, throughout all that was done, making it, indeed, yet another successful year.



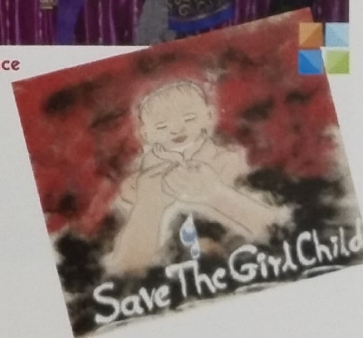

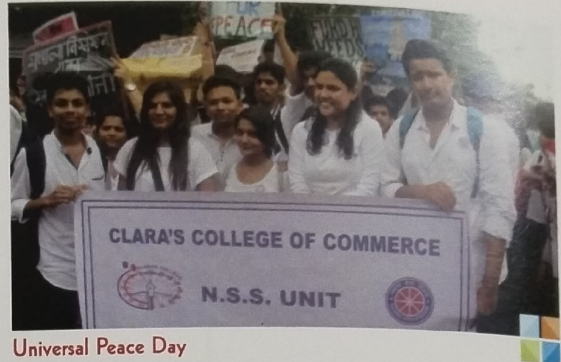

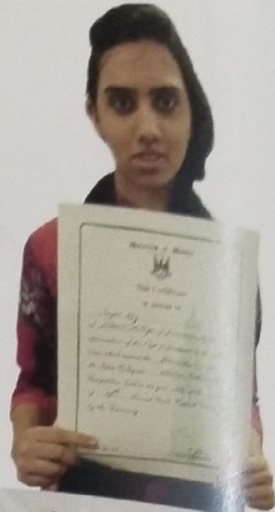

YOUTH FESTIVAL

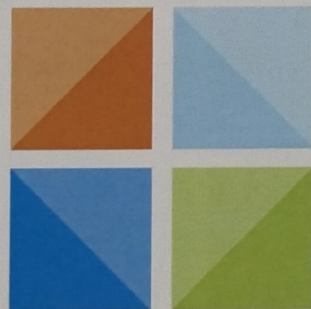

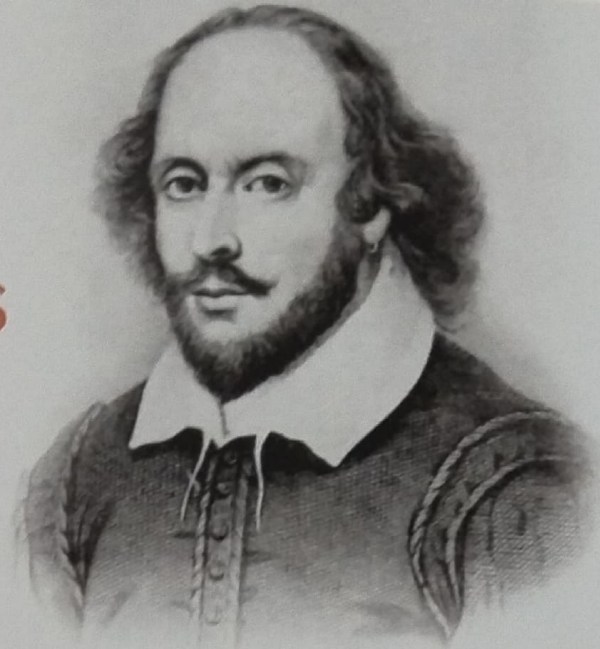

By William Shakespeare

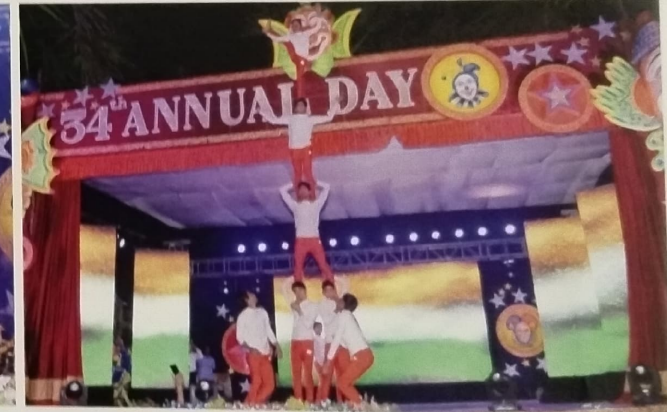


All the world's a stage,

Sans teeth, sans eyes, sans taste, sans everything.

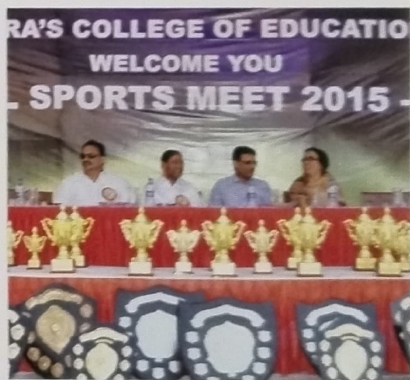
