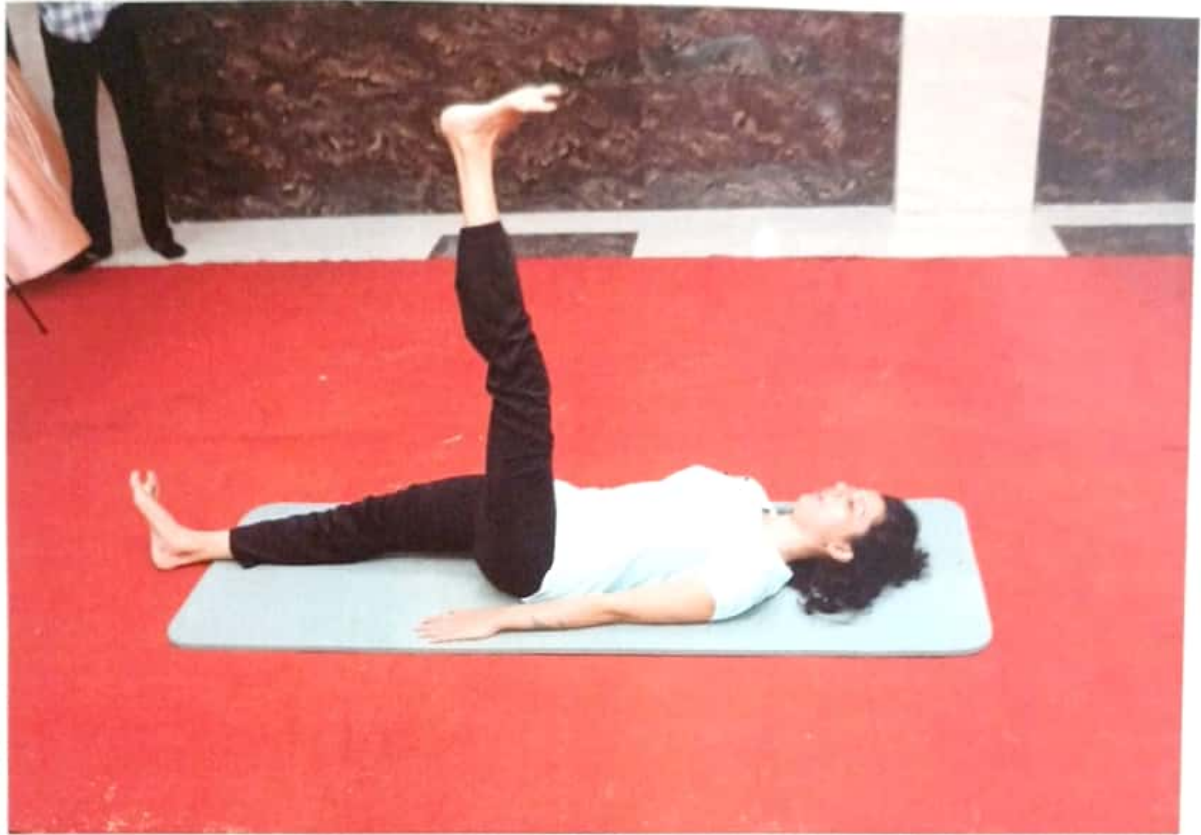

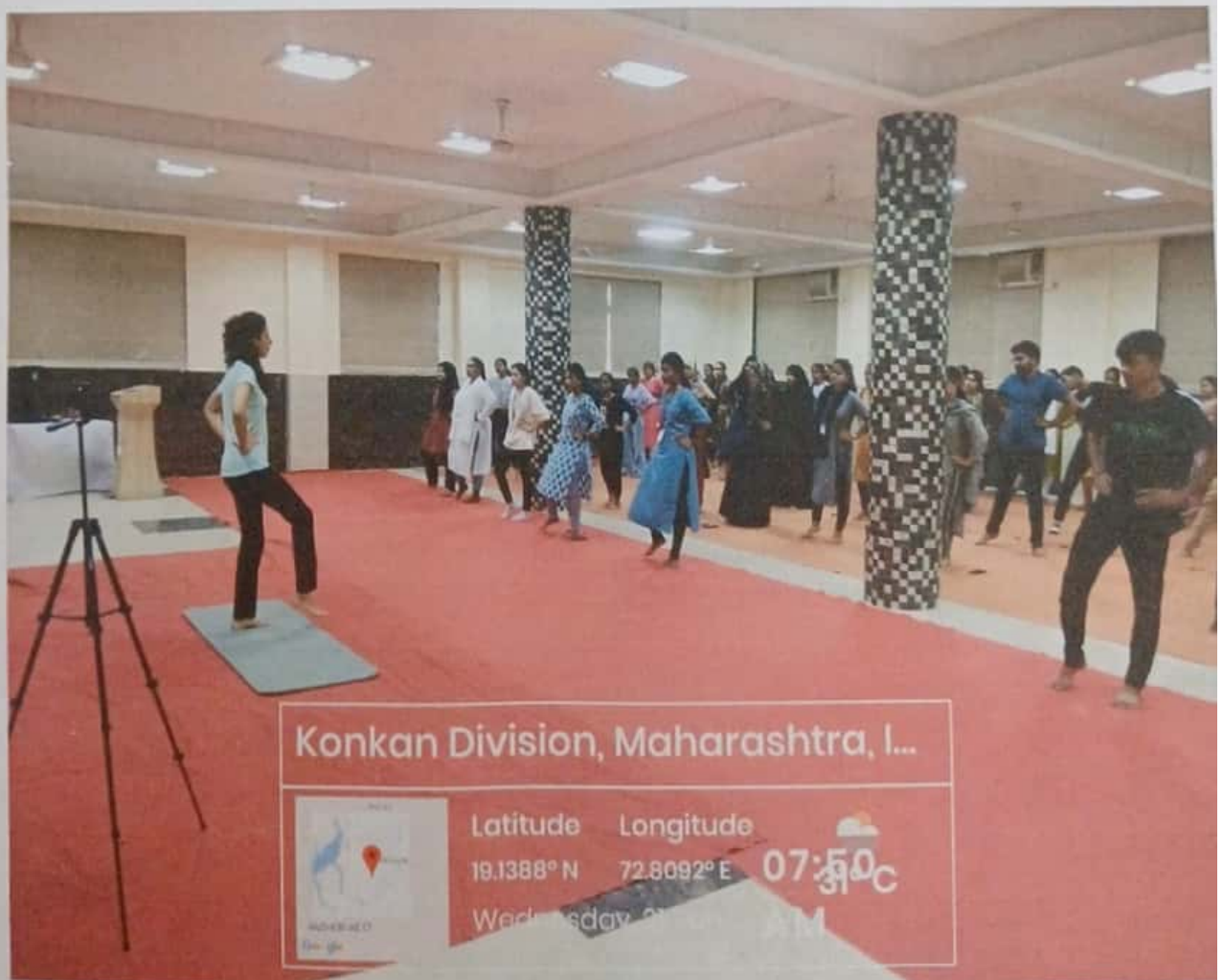

An Anti-drug awareness program was conducted in the institute by IQAC & NSS UNIT on the occasion of International Day Against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking. API Shrikant Karkar, API Dada Gaikwad, ASI Ankush Lushte, WHC Anita Chaurse were invited as a chief guest and resource person for creating an awareness on the ill-effects of drug and alcohol consumption, in a comprehensive manner. Sri. Shrikant Karkar from the Anti Narcotics Cell from the crime branch was the motivational speaker who created awareness on the ill effects of drugs and its usage, he stated some facts which included the increasing number of youngsters getting addicted to alcohol and drugs. He also added a report by the central government demonstrated that the vast majority of youth are receiving drug and alcohol prevention messages from sources such as TV, radio, posters and pamphlets, Movie ads and campaigns. Furthermore, the report on its special analysis showed that those who have been exposed to such messages are significantly less likely to abuse drugs.

The Government of India is taking every visible effort to prevent teen drug use via the National Youth Anti-Drug Media Campaign, especially for those making the difficult transition from schools to colleges via their National-level Anti-Drug Policies.

Sir stated that the youth are the largest force of our nation and it must be directed in a positive way for their happy, healthy and holy living. Shri Dada Galkwad expressed that youth only can save themselves by conducting a large number of events campaigning the anti-drug messages to make a significant impact in the society. He said that Mumbai Police is taking all necessary measures about bringing awareness into the public via TV, radio, posters, pamphlets and movies advertises on anti- alcohol and drug prevention messages in the past 2 years rigorously. In this event, Principal, Teachers, Students of Degree and Junior College and NSS unit were present for the session. Such little steps taken together by the college and students will surely help in fostering strong mental and social health amongst today's youths so that they connect with their peers, their elders, their community and their environment.





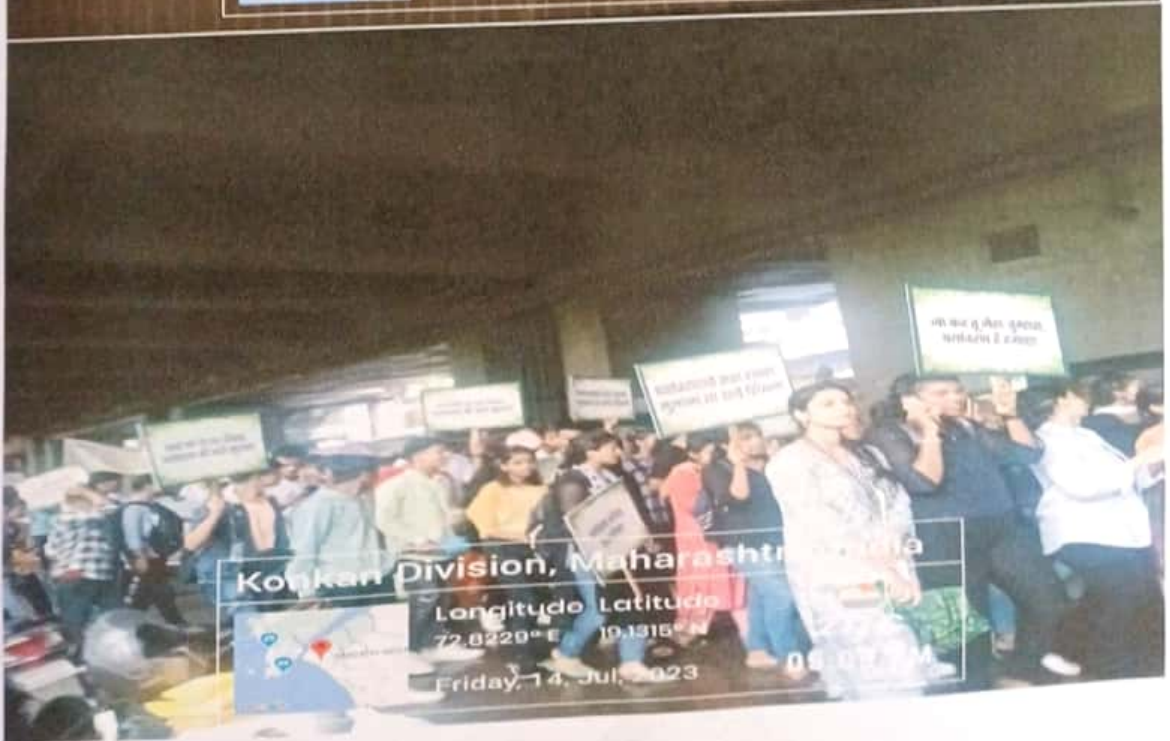

Like humans, trees too have lives and feelings. As we all know that the whole world is facing the problem of global warming and to recover from such problem planting the trees has become one of the most important today's aspects. Keeping this in mind, NSS Unit of Clara's College of Commerce participated in the Environmental rally. Rally commenced from Chacha Nehru Park besides Versova Metro Station at 4.30 pm and culminated to Orchid International School at 6.00 pm .

A Phenomenal gathering of 6000+ attendees including NGOs, N.S.S units of various colleges of Western Suburban Zone, Schools & Local communities united in this rally and marched to raise awareness about environmental issues and raise their voices in support of environmental conservation. They sensitized the masses about the menace of environmental degradation and suggested measures to reduce the usage of plastic and increase the plantation of trees.

It is found that most of the hospitalization cases and leading cause of death are because of the road trauma. Everyone should learn the road traffic and safety rules at a very early age to perform safer behaviours in the later life. It is essential, therefore, to ensure that, as far as possible, we can all use the roads safely. The human and economic damage caused by road crashes is largely preventable.

Keeping this in mind, N.S.S. Unit of Clara's College of Commerce organized an Awareness and Demonstration Session on Road Safety in association with United Way Of Mumbai- A non-profit organisation who is working in urban and rural communities across India to identify and implement the most impactful solutions to community problems. 

"If helmet saves life, why not wear it?"

In India, 4 people die every hour because of not wearing helmet. This is a serious issue to be taken into account. Wearing a helmet decreases the risk and severity of injuries by 72 percent.

To educate people about the necessity of wearing helmets, and to create safety awareness, the N.S.S. Unit of Clara's College of Commerce organized Training on 'Helmet for Life' in association with United Way of Mumbai and Total Energy Foundation on 26th July 2023 at 10.00 am in the A.V. Room. The Helmet for Life initiative aims to promote safe two-wheeler riding by educating people about the importance of wearing helmets for safety, creating awareness about safe riding practices, and motivating them to follow compliance norms, with the ultimate goal of reducing two-wheeler road accidents. The training involved theoretical and practical guidance to potential two-wheeler riders to mitigate the issue. The session was conducted by Mr. Roshan Kate, Member of United Way of Mumbai. Mr. Roshan Kate spoke about the needs to follow traffic rules to avoid accidents and do's and don'ts while selecting a helmet to protect oneself from serious head injuries. He insisted that pillion riders should wear helmets. "A pillion is the most unaware person. Riders can be alert if they see danger ahead a few seconds before the mishap but the pillion, especially

children and youth, are not alert and often we find pillion riders have maximum fatalities," he added.

In a bid to inform and educate students the importance of head safety gear during riding or accompanying pillion riders, 25 free helmets were distributed to students. Overall, it was an interactive and informative session that helped in inculcating a sense of road safety among the young students of our country.

It showcased the difference in the scenario of a road mishap by the simple presence of a helmet. It was a worthy effort and an effective measure to spread road safety awareness.



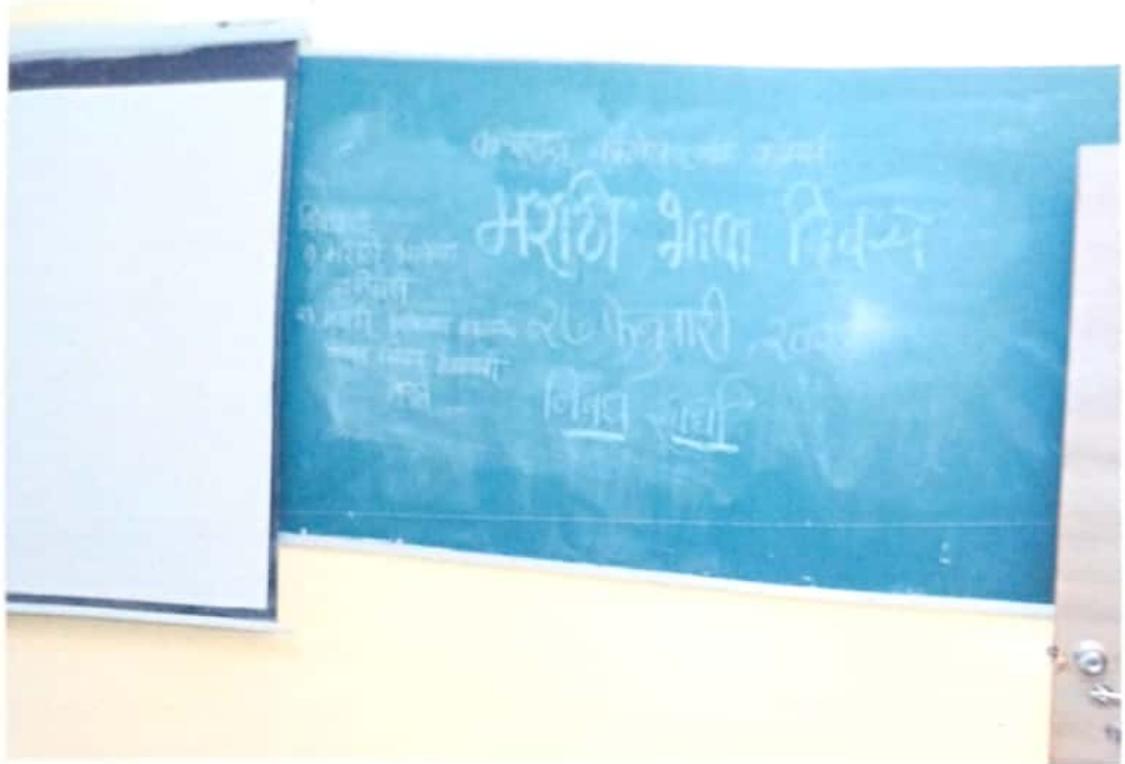

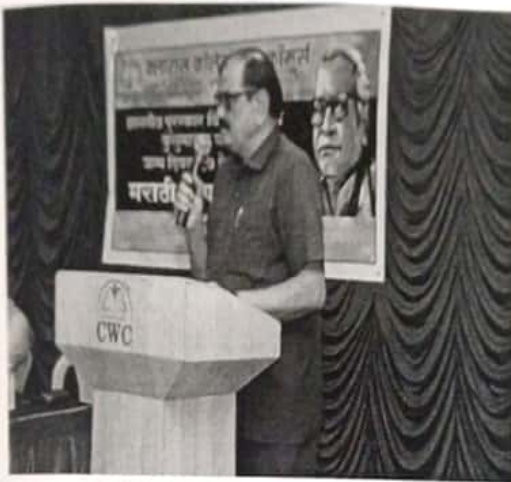
Report

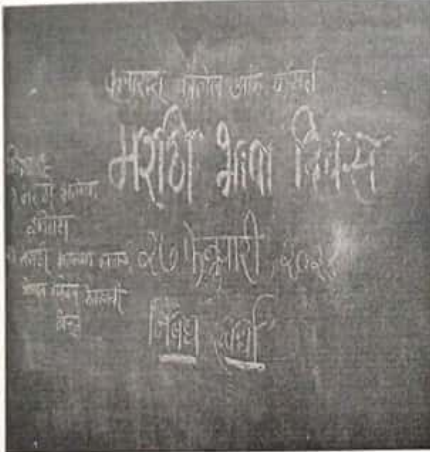
Then, the students recited some Marathi poems written by Kusumagraj, which were appreciated by everyone present. Students also sang Maharashtra Geet and performed traditional dances.

REPORT
